

3 REASONS WHY DOAJ MATTERS

- DOAJ is considered the most important community-driven, open access service in the world.
 (www.knowledge-ex-change.info/event/oa-dependencies)
- We have established the de facto standard for open access journals and publishing.
- Open access publication funds often refer to and rely on DOAJ indexing to release funding.

4 WAYS DOAJ MAKES AN IMPACT



Helps publishers to improve their operations & make their journals more attractive publishing channels.

Encourages a shift away from impact factors to focus on the details of true policies & practices.
