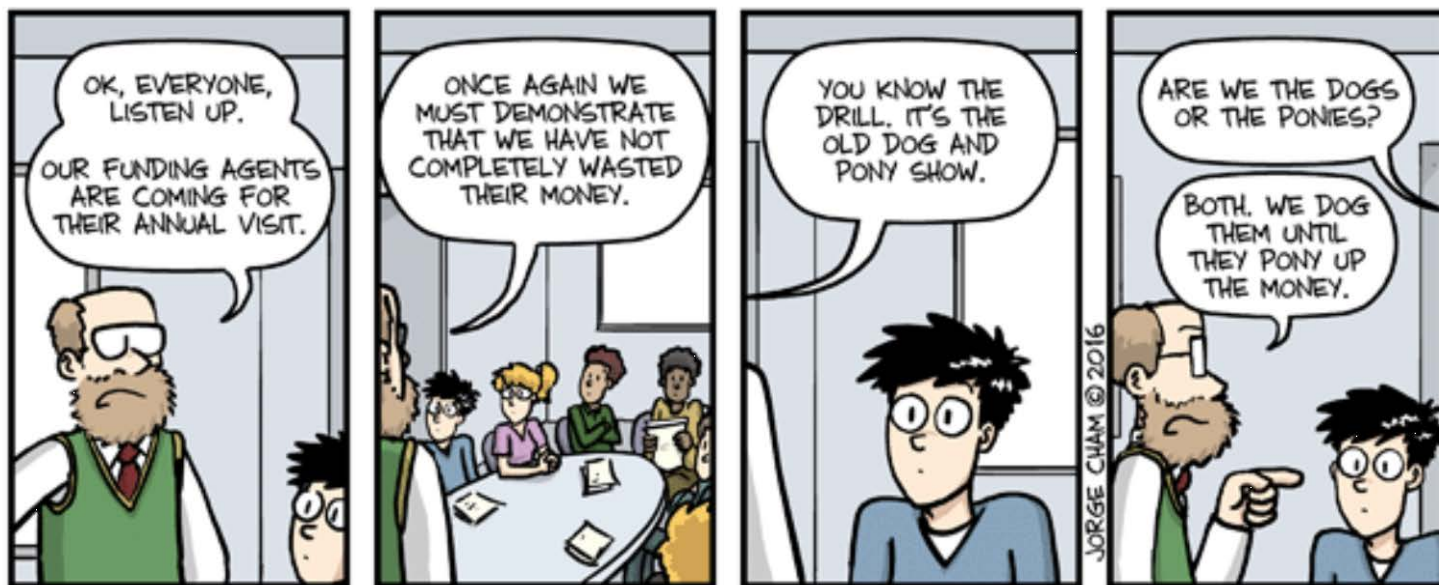

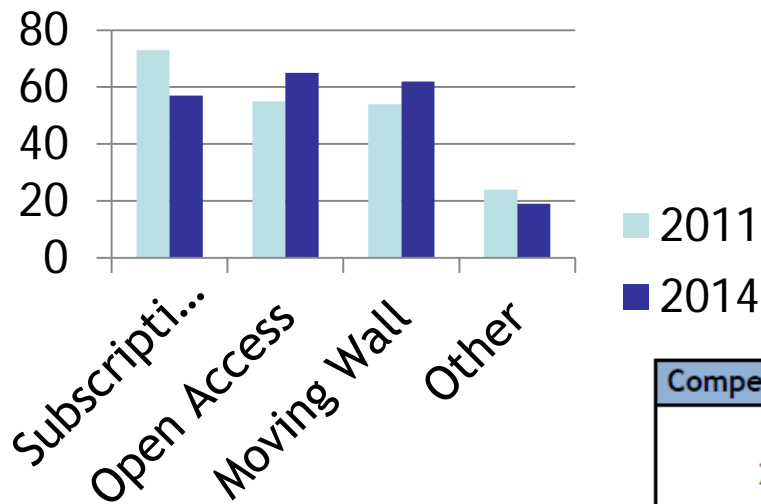

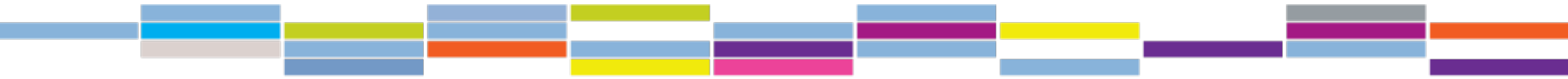

Applies to all grants awarded May 1, 2015 and onward.

Any peer-reviewed journal publication arising from Agency-supported research must be freely available within 12 months of publication.
